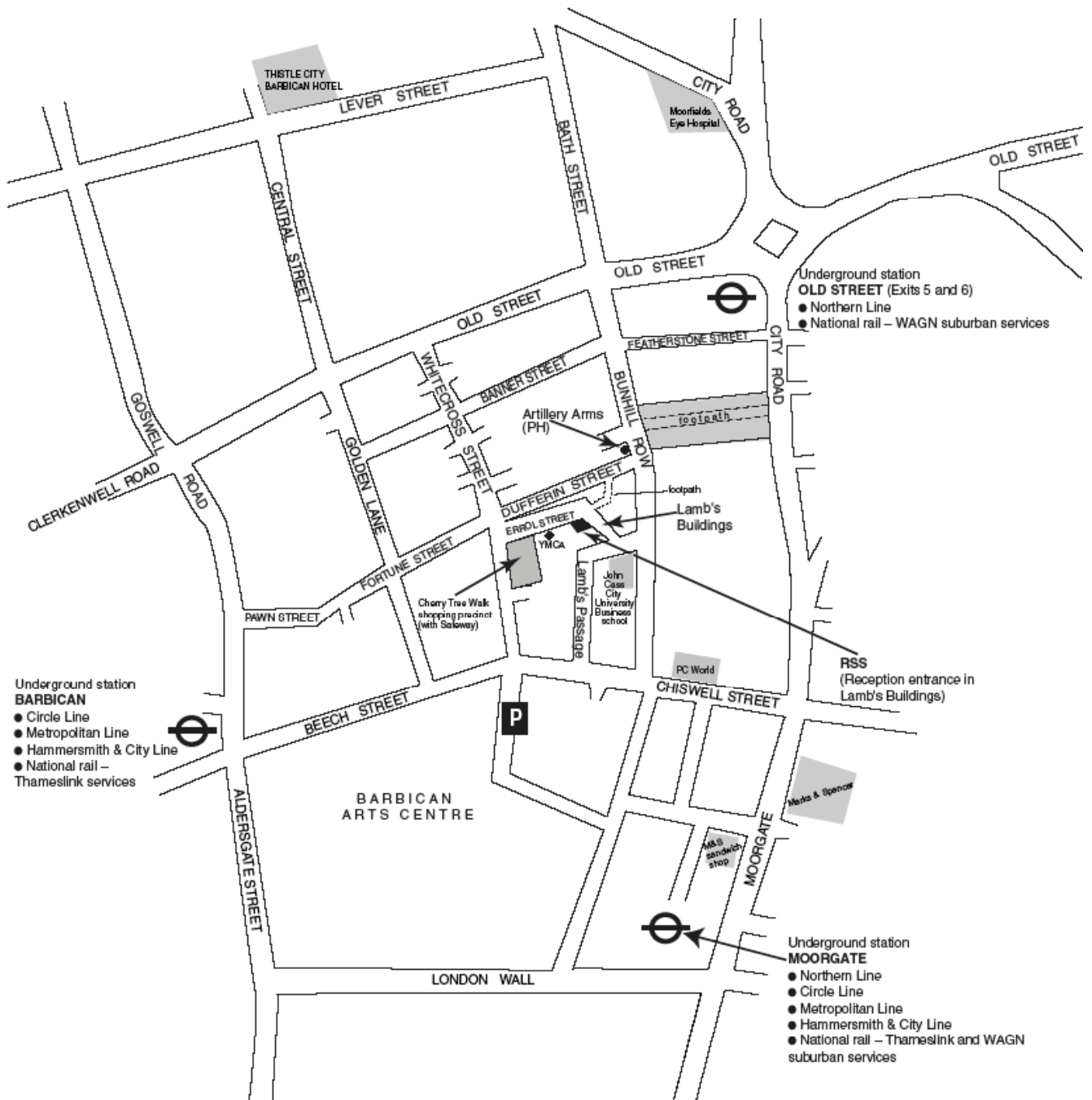
The nearest Tube stations are Barbican, Liverpool Street, Old Street and Moorgate. See the map on page 2
